## Activity-13: What do animals eat?

## **Note to the instructor:**

The table includes animals from all unique divisions of kingdom Animalia. The reason for such an exhaustive table is the very fact that animals are distributed across the globe very differently.

Thus this table guarantees at least one animal to the students from various regions: from the coast, near a forest area and from the city.

## **Procedure:**

Here is a list of animals. Try to find any, some or all of them (as many possible) in your surroundings and tabulate them.

The second table lists all kinds of food eaten by these animals. The list is not complete. Observe animals and keep adding to the list.

After doing so, match appropriate food items against appropriate animals.
